UNFCCC Decision 1/CP.16:
develop *‘a national strategy or action plan’*

- Location of potential sites/zones for REDD+ activities
- Specific policies/interventions to implement
 - national/local priorities
 - suitability of different locations
 - spatial variability in risks/benefits
