INSTITUTIONAL SET UP

- ZAMBIA IS A SIGNATORY TO THE UNFCCC
 - MTENR IS THE FOCAL POINT FOR THE UNFCCC
 - CDM BOARD
 - DESIGNATED NATIONAL AUTHORITY IN PLACE
 - CLIMATE CHANGE SECRETARIAT BEING ESTABLISHED AT MTENR
 - DNA EXPERIENCED IN SELECTING PROJECTS FOR CDM APPROVAL
 - **ENERGY SWITCH PROJECT SELECTED. APPROVED THROUGH DNA**

FOREST SECTOR

- THE TOTAL WOODED AREA OF ZAMBIA IS 66%,
- OF WHICH 47% IS MIOMBO VEGETATION
- 487 FOREST RESERVES COVERING 7.91 % OF LAND AREA IN ZAMBIA
- 60,000 HA PLANTATION FORESTS
- 5000 HA PRIVATE FORESTS
- 7000 HA
- ZAMBIA HAS DUAL LAND TENURE SYSTEM
 - STATUTORY LAND (30)
 - CUSTOMARY LANDS (70)
- CONFLICTS IN LAND USE
 - AGRICULTURE
 - SETTLEMENTS
- DEFORESTATION 350,000 HA/ANNUM
- REDD CAN ADDRESS FOREST COVER DECREASE
